

**Lanier Middle School**  
**Division B Invitational Science Olympiad Tournament**  
**Registration Form**  
**Saturday, December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

Lanier Middle School will be hosting a Division B Invitational Tournament; this tournament is open only to Virginia schools. Tournament admittance will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis, with spaces reserved upon confirmed receipt of registration and payment. **The registration deadline is Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017 but may close early if we reach our capacity of 30 teams.**

Registration fees will pay for tournament awards and the facilities. Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 schools with no more than 1 trophy per school, and medals will be awarded to the top 5 places in individual events.

Every participating school will write and run an event – including all materials (tests, equipment, etc.) and personnel (assistant proctor, timers, graders, etc.) needed to run the event. Schools with two teams will provide one additional adult to assist in running events. Each school will also provide a 'volunteer at large' to assist on the day of the tournament. On the registration form, you will be asked to indicate your top 5 event preferences; you must include at least *three* events that feature a written test or examination.

We will run all Virginia events. With respect to the time that competing will have to prepare, Battery Buggy, Roller Coaster, Towers, and Wright Stuff will be run as trial events (*do not count to the school's official medal tally; students competing in these events will still win medals*). We will follow the Regional rules in the manual where a distinction is made and follow the Virginia event clarifications. The schedule blocks may be adapted to accommodate the competition capacity, but we will attempt to avoid event conflicts that contrast with the official Virginia Science Olympiad event schedule. The tournament schedule will be shared by Nov 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

All participating teams will receive a copy of the tournament tests (where available) and answer keys electronically – additionally, teams will receive their copies of their tests and results following the Awards Ceremony.

Concessions will be provided by our Lanier FCCLA; we ask that teams not bring in outside food.
